### **Language**

- Official Language: French
- English is commonly spoken at hotels, restaurants, major attractions, and tourist areas.

### **Currency**

- Currency: Euro (€)
- Credit cards are widely accepted, but carrying a small amount of cash is recommended for cafés, markets, and smaller shops.

### **Time Zone**

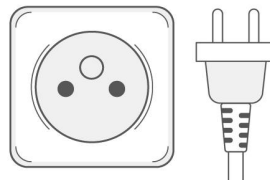
- Central European Time (CET) – UTC+1 (starting the last Sunday of October)

- Fall (September–November): 50–70°F (10–21°C)
- Comfortable walking shoes and a light jacket or umbrella are recommended throughout much of the year.

- Voltage: 230V
- Frequency: 50Hz
- Plug Types: Type C and Type E

Paris has an extensive and reliable public transportation network that includes the Metro, buses, commuter trains (RER), and trams. Walking is one of the best ways to experience the city's neighborhoods, while taxis and rideshare services are readily available.
