San Diego, California

San Diego is a city on the Pacific coast of California known for its beaches, parks and warm climate. Immense Balboa Park is the site of the renowned San Diego Zoo, as well as numerous art galleries, artist studios, museums and gardens. A deep harbor is home to a large active naval fleet, with the USS Midway, an aircraft-carrier-turned-museum, open to the public.

Tipping: One of the primary areas where tipping is prevalent in San Diego, CA is the restaurant industry. The standard tipping rate for waiters is generally around 15%-20% of the bill before tax is applied. This is a good baseline for satisfactory service. However, if the service was exceptional, you may consider tipping more.

Weather Conditions: In February, San Diego is cool and mild, with average high temperatures in the mid-60s°F and lows around 50°F. It is one of the city's wetter months, though rainfall is not frequent or heavy.

Local Attractions

Balboa Park

This 1,200-acre nature park comprises 17 museums, gardens, musical theaters, a sports complex, and the world-famous San Diego Zoo. The park's Spanish-Moorish architecture and 19 distinct gardens (some require admission fees) attract both tourists and locals.

USS Midway Museum

Located in downtown San Diego, the USS Midway (Museum) was America's longest-serving aircraft carrier of the 20th century. Today, the interactive museum is an unforgettable adventure for the entire family as guests walk in the footsteps of the 225,000 young men who served on Midway. Visiting Midway is a once-in-a-lifetime experience in San Diego, known around the world as "Navy Town, USA."

Coronado Island

Featuring miles of spacious beaches, a pretty main street, and a historic seafront resort, Coronado Island makes a pleasant day trip from San Diego. Walk along Orange Avenue to browse the boutiques and try great food, from cozy bistros to burger joints. Head off to the waterfront to explore the dunes and lounge on the soft sand of the island's several beaches. You can drive to Coronado Island through Coronado Bridge or take a 15-minute ferry ride from Broadway Pier in San Diego.

Sunset Cliffs Natural Park

As the name suggests, this park's rugged coastline features magnificent ocean views at sunset. Don't miss the chance to explore the tide pools—be careful as some parts of the climb down can be uneven and steep. Sunset Cliffs Natural Park is also a great spot to see gray whales passing by on their migration. There are drinking fountains throughout the park, but there aren't any food establishments nearby—pack lunch as it's a perfect spot for picnics.
